Judging Process

- All completed judging rubrics will be returned to organizing committee by **24 March 2010**.
- The top 5 departments will be short-listed and a discussion will be held on **26 March 2010** to decide on the three top award winners.
- **Prize presentation** will be held on **30 March 2010**.

Judging Rubrics

Criterion	Descriptors
Lesson Effectiveness (30 m)	▪ The objectives of the lesson / teaching package are clearly stated. (5 m)
	▪ Students are able to achieve the objectives of the learning package. (10 m)
	▪ The lesson(s) engage(s) students to learn with sustained interest. (15 m)
Practicality (15 m)	▪ The learning package can be easily produced for crisis that requires home-based learning sessions.
Innovation & Improvement (5 m)	▪ The learning package contains ideas that are creative and original.
